The WWFF program encourages amateur radio operators to operate portable from designated parks and/or protected nature areas around the world, and in turn generate attention for these areas, whilst providing the amateur radio community an interesting and rewarding activity.

The Australian (VKFF) program commenced in March 2013.

Qualifying reference areas in Australia include National Parks, Conservation Parks, Nature Reserves, Marine Parks and various other parks.

There are over 2,000 qualifying reference areas in all States and Territories of Australia.

Each qualifying Australian park is issued with a unique VKFF reference number, e.g. VKFF-0010.
